

## Challenge Evaluation Norms and Procedures

### A. Applying for Challenge Evaluation

1. The students can fill the challenge evaluation within 15 days from the date of declaration of result by the University. The student may file application on prescribed **'Challenge Evaluation Form'** and submit to the Learning Centre.
2. The time period will be calculated from the date of **'Result Notification'** by University.
3. The challenge evaluation should be done only for the papers in which candidate does not secure passing marks, this facility is not for the candidate who has already passed the subject.
4. The challenge evaluation can be done for any no. of papers, in which the student is confident to pass/secure at least 7.5 more marks.
5. The Learning Centre will have to submit the collected applications within 5 days to the Regional Centre.
6. The Regional Centre will have to submit the collected applications from LCs within 5 days to the University.

### B. Nomination of Faculty by Student

1. The students have an option to nominate a Faculty of their choice for each subject, who should be at least a Post Graduate in the relevant field with minimum 2 years experience (who is not their relative) and must be working as Faculty in a College / Learning Centre.
2. The answer sheet will be evaluated by the University nominated Faculty in the presence of the student's nominated faculty.
3. The Challenge Evaluation of the University faculty will be final and binding on all concerned.

### C. Fee and Refund of Fee

1. Fee of challenge evaluation is Rs. 1000/- per subject. However the fee is refundable in case the challenge is considered successful.
2. The guidelines for challenge evaluation will be under following conditions :
  - a. The difference of marks after the new evaluation and previous evaluation is 10% or more of the Maximum Marks (e.g. more than 7.5 marks in present case where the maximum marks of the subject are 75). The fee will be refunded.
  - b. If student secures passing marks or more than passing marks after new evaluation but the difference between new evaluation and previous evaluation is less than 10% of maximum marks. (e.g., a student secures 26 marks in previous evaluation and secures 30 marks after challenge evaluation; the difference between marks is 4). In this case the student will be declared pass but the fee will not be refunded.
